

Symposium on Yacht Design and Yacht Building 2005

On November 4-5, 2005 during the Hamburg Boat Show, the Show Organizers hold a Symposium on Yacht Design and Yacht Construction in Hamburg on the premises of the show. The Symposium gathers specialists from the industry both building and designing staff. It is the only venue of it's kind in the German speaking countries.

Topics of Interest include:

- Bonding in marine applications
- Laminates (Winding, tape-putting and fibre placement techniques and new fibres)
- Software (laminare calculation, prediction, sail design etc.)
- Systems on board (Canting keels, dagger boards, rudders)
- Building techniques (5 axis milling etc.)
- Water Jet propulsion
- Materials (fibre rigging, thermoplastics)
- Unusual projects (must not be boats, but applicable to the boating Ind.)
- Any other subject (make your comment)

Call for Papers

Authors are invited to submit papers contributing to the overall topics of the symposium, other suggestions are welcome. The submission of papers for the symposium should include information about the authors, and abstracts of 100-200 words in length together with a list of key words. We will review the abstracts received for final approval and inclusion in the Program. Those authors with accepted papers will receive detailed information on format and sending of the papers.

Deadline and key dates

Submission of abstracts: April 30th, 2005
Acceptance notification: June 2003
Submission of papers: September 20th 2005

Language

Official languages of the Symposium will be German and English, accepting papers and technical presentation on the sessions in any of these languages. A simultaneous translation system will be available for the technical sessions. The presentations should be backed by PowerPoint (or equivalent) el. format. All presentations are then issued on a CD and provided to participants. Also additional information like pictures, films etc. could be incorporated on the CD.
